New York, June 30.—There was no foundation in fact for the story published in some of the morning papers here that a tally-ho coach had capsized, rolled down a steep embankment, and sunk in twenty feet of water in Budd's Lake, New Jersey, last evening, drowning two persons from Washington and seriously injuring others. The story was a pure fabrication.
